1st: Dosetshyre Hengistbury Ed - (Mrs J. Hicks)

A first show for puppy and owner and he was very nicely presented. A smart young man with a lovely head pattern, well balanced with a lovely dark eye and sweet yet masculine expression. Good length to height ratio and sturdy bone. Nice overall shape and balance and has time to develop a steadier gait. Pleased to award him Best Puppy.

PUPPY DOG (1)

1st: Dosetshyre Hengistbury Ed - (Mrs J. Hicks)

JUNIOR DOG (3 / 1 Abs)

1st: Beardora Roly Poly - (Mrs E. & Mr R. Christopherson)

Slightly smaller slate boy who I would have preferred to be a little more masculine. Head was well balanced with a nice expression. Nicely presented and stood well. Moved steadily and in accordance with construction.

2nd: Cheslasa Private Eye on Scotesham - (Mrs A. M. Buswell)

Brown who I preferred in some ways to first as he had a better body length and size. Well balanced in head but just lost out on less positive movement.

YEARLING DOG (1)

1st: Full of the Dickens Winner Takes It All for Kingswud (Imp Due) JW - (Mrs S. Collins)

Smart young dog with a very attractive body shape. Good reach of neck and well laid shoulder. A better return of upper arm would have improved his reach on the move. Well balanced in head and lovely masculine expression. Very nicely presented.

MAIDEN DOG (1)

1st: Sefton A Dream of Bear'd avec Cinquepaws (Imp Fra) NAF - (Mrs V. M. & Mr A. M. Harrison)

Not in his best coat today but this accentuated his well balanced body. Good reach of neck and proudly held head of correct proportions. Not as positive on the move.

1st: Full of the Dickens Winner Takes It All for Kingswud (Imp Due) JW - (Mrs S. Collins)

POST GRADUATE DOG (2 / 1 Abs)

1st: Beaboardies Golden Brown - (Mr P. J. & Mrs L. M. Rowan)

Well balanced brown dog with correct proportions throughout. Good reach of neck and probably the best front angulation so far but not as positive in hind movement. Lovely head pattern with well filled muzzle and charming expression.

LIMIT DOG (3 / 1 Abs)

1st: Eltimaris Hip Hip Hooray - (Mrs J. Webb)

Very masculine well balanced dog beautifully presented in good coat and condition. Good length of rib and level topline which he held on the move. Correct substance for size with good legs and feet. Nice reach of neck creating an elegant and attractive outline. Well laid shoulder and nicely angulated hind quarters allowed him to drive well from behind. Head was well balanced with flat skull correct stop and well filled muzzle and a lovely soft and melting yet masculine expression. Moved confidently and was pleased to award him Best Dog and BIS

2nd: Beaboardies Golden Brown - (Mr P. J. & Mrs L. M. Rowan)

OPEN DOG (6 / 2 Abs)

1st: Eltimaris Hip Hip Hooray - (Mrs J. Webb)

Slate dog with good proportions throughout. Stood soundly on good legs and feet. Shapely neck and level topline. Well balanced head.

VETERAN DOG (4)

1st: Snowmead Simply brilliant at Nadene - (Misses E. Maher & Misses D. Richardson)

Smart dog of 8 years enjoying his day out and looking the part. Good balance for size. well laid shoulder and elegant reach of neck, top line and shapely hind quarters. Moved positively. Correct head proportions and lovely melting expression. A lovely picture in profile.

2nd: Potterdale Magic Dust ShCM - (Mrs C. Lewry & Mrs J. Lewis)

At 11 years was in lovely condition and very well presented. Many of the above remarks apply and it was a hair splitting decision between the two lovely veterans.

JUNIOR BITCH (4 / 1 Abs)

First of two lovely young bitches, I see they were litter sisters and very hard to separate. 1st had less finish coatwise but was slightly longer in rib and I felt had the better overall balance and outline.

This bitch was very feminine and had more finish than her sister. Both had lovely head patterns and well set eyes giving a very sweet feminine expression.

GRADUATE BITCH (3 / 1 Abs)

POST GRADUATE BITCH (7 / 3 Abs)

1st: Eltimaris Jubilee Hoorah JW - (Mrs J. & Mr S Patterson)

I see this is the litter sister to BIS. A beautifully presented very feminine bitch with lovely head qualities and expression. Good body lines and elegant outline and moved with style.

2nd: Hot Favourite for Marsby - (Mrs J. & Mr R. Swaby)

Another lovely bitch presented in lovely coat and condition. Well balanced head qualities with sweet feminine expression. Just preferred the slightly better reach of neck on 1st.

3rd: Moonhill Blissful Dream - (Mr M. & Mrs S. Fookes)

LIMIT BITCH (4 / 2 Abs)

1st: Beaboardies Cinnamon Girl - (Mrs L. Bevis)

Very attractive brown girl who won this class on her beautifully balanced outline. Proud reach of neck, well laid shoulder, level topline and lovely shape over the croup, with well bent stifle. Her head was beautifully proportioned with broad flat skull and well rounded muzzle and a lovely feminine expression completed the picture. Pressed hard for top honours but the dog just had the better finish on the day.

2nd: Eltimaris Platinum Pudding JW - (Mrs J. & Mr S Patterson)

Another lovely bitch who pressed hard for first place but just preferred the body length of 1.

Correct breed type in many ways with nice head properties and sweet expression. Well laid shoulder and good hind movement.
